South Asian

India it is the seventh largest country by area and second most populous country and democratic in the world. Indian Arts one of the most splendid is the Taj Majal built in 1632 by Shah Jahan in the memory of his wife. Taj Majal is the one architecture of love story and the most beautiful monument by the Moguls it is entirely made of white domed marble its stunning architectural beauty beyond the adequate description it place from the dawn to sunset in Agra District in Uttar Pradesh.





West Asian

Iran has one of the richest art heritage in the world history. The minaret of Shoustar Jame Mosque in Isfahan, build in early 8th Century CE is among the first minarets erected in Iran following the advent of Islam. the rectangular hall or space, usually vaulted, walled on the three sides, with one end entirely open. It is build for aesthetic reasons, as well as to place Masyrabias windows and to lessen the extend of sunlight to pour in the building.

Central Asian

Tajikistan Carving is most present in architectural monuments, household structures and objects, musical instruments, and souvenirs. The art of decorative carving is very important for local residents. Tajik's carving gradually changed to Arabian inscriptions using images of people and animals while some carvers prefers "vegetative," geometrical pattern. In architecture, ornaments in the form of lotus, tulips, and other flowers are more common.


