MATERIALS:

Old newspaper,
Acrylic or enamel paint,
Bottle or vase
Pencil
Brushes of different sizes



PROCEDURES:

Prepare your work place by spreading old newspaper as your placemat.

1. Choose either the white or black paint as your base. Apply the paint and let it dry.
2. Plan the design you want to be painted on your pot. Apply the elements and principles of design in Indian art.
3. Using your pencil, sketch out your design on the pot.
4. Use your paint and brush to create your design. Let it dry.
5. Display your work for assessment.
