PROCEDURES:

Prepare your work place by spreading old newspaper as your placemat.

- 1. Choose either the white or black paint as your base. Apply the paint and let it dry.
- 2. Plan the design you want to be painted on your pot. Apply the elements and principles of design in Indian art.
- 3. Using your pencil, sketch out your design on the pot.
- 4. Use your paint and brush to create your design. Let it dry.
- 5. Display your work for assessment.
