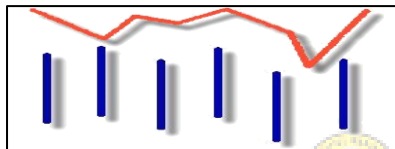

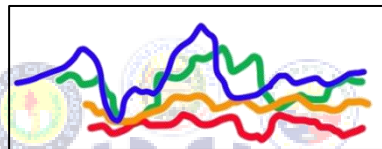

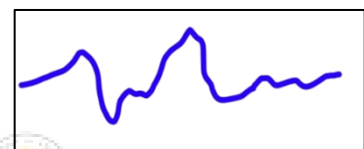

BRIEF INTRODUCTION

Musical texture is how the melodic, rhythmic, and harmonic materials are combined in a composition, thus determining the overall quality of the sound in a piece. It is described in regard to the density, or thickness, and range, or width, between lowest and highest pitches, in relative terms as well as more specifically distinguished according to the number of voices, or parts, and the relationship between voices and thick texture contains many “layers” of instruments.

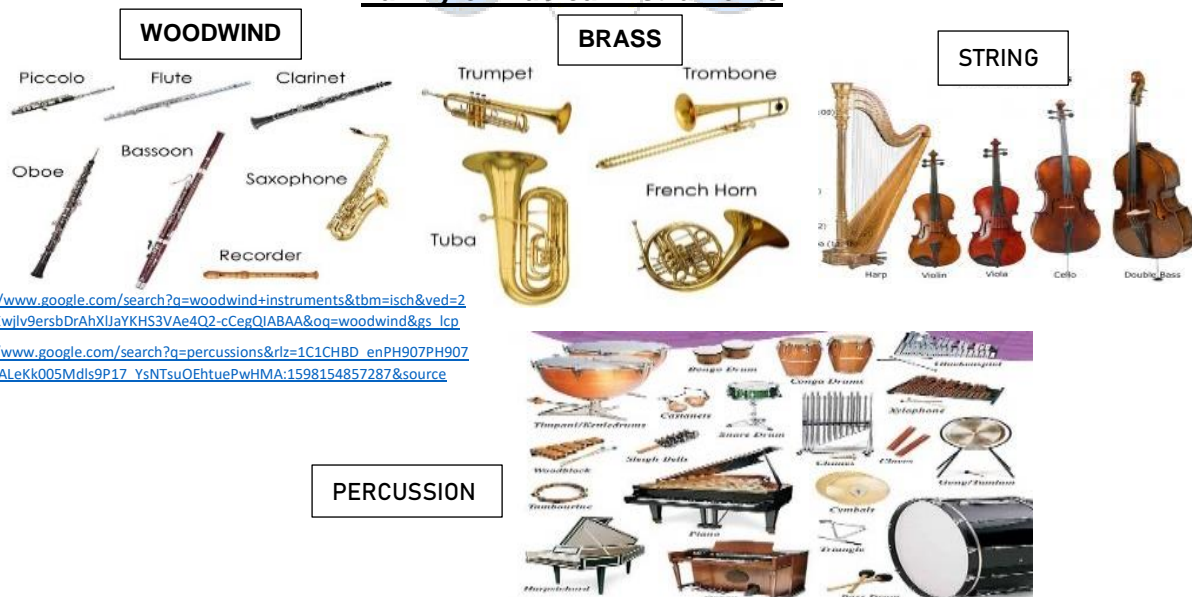

Different Textures in Instrumental Music

1. SOLO

In music, a solo (from the Italian: solo, meaning alone) is a piece or a section of piece played or sung featuring a single performer, who may be performing completely alone or supported by an accompanying instrument such as piano or organ. The performer is a soloist.

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2. ENSEMBLE

It comes from the Middle French word ensemble which means “together, at the same time”. Ensemble in instrumental means group of musicians playing together. A musical ensemble also known as a musical group who perform instrumental or vocal music which has its own characteristic sound.

TYPES OF ENSEMBLES

- **Trio** – a group of **three musicians**. They can be made up of different arrangements of instruments.

- **Quartet** – a group of **four musicians** playing together. They can be made up of different variations of instruments.

- **Orchestra** – a group of musicians that can vary in size from **25** to over **100**. They are made up of different sections of instruments: **String, Woodwinds, Brass and Percussion**.

REMEMBER

Texture is the way rhythm, melody, and harmony are combined in a composition to see the overall quality of the sound. It is the thinness or thickness of a musical piece heard. It also refers to the overall quality of single or several layers of sounds heard at the same time.
