- **IV. Instructions:** Read about the business practices and history of early 20<sup>th</sup> century China. List down important events and write them on the graphic organizer below.



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- I. Activity No.: 2 Deixis in Literature
- **II. Objective(s):** Analyze the dominant deictic elements to reveal the historical/biographical influences/background of an Afro-Asian short story.
- **III. Materials Needed:** copy of *Things Fall Apart Chapter 1*, and pen
- **IV. Instructions:** Identify lines from Chapter 1 of *Things Fall Apart* by Chinua Achebe which show the relationship of narrator and time (time deixis) and narrator and place (place deixis). Underline the deictic words/phrases used to describe and reveal time and place.
