I. Activity No. 2: Navigating and Editing in a Video Editing Application

II. Objective(s): This activity aims to practice navigating the user interface (UI) of a video editing application and to arrange video clips on the timeline and use basic editing tools such as trim, crop, and transitions.

III. Materials Needed:

- Computers or devices with a video editing application installed (e.g., iMovie, Adobe Premiere Pro, DaVinci Resolve, Final Cut Pro)
- Sample video clips for import (provided by the teacher or available online)
- Instructional handout or digital guide on basic navigation and editing tools of the chosen video editing application

IV. Instructions:

1. Open the video editing application on your device.
2. Click on the "Import Media" button.
3. Select the provided sample video clips and import them into the media library.
4. Drag and drop the imported video clips from the media library to the timeline.
5. Arrange the clips in a sequence that tells a simple story or follows a logical order.
6. Select one of the clips on the timeline. Use the trim tool to remove any unwanted sections from the beginning or end of the clip.
7. Select another clip and use the crop tool to focus on a specific area of the video.
8. Add a transition effect between two clips. Click on the transitions tab in the toolbar, choose a transition, and drag it to the timeline between the clips.
9. Use the preview window to play the video and review the changes made.
10. Make any necessary adjustments based on what you see in the preview.
11. Share your edited video with the class or in small groups.
12. Discuss the editing choices you made and any challenges you encountered.
13. Be guided with the rubric in developing this activity.

Lesson Title/Topic:	Basic Editing Techniques - Trim and Crop and Adding Text, Effects, Images, Transitions, Narration, and Audio Effects

I. Activity No. 3: Enhancing and Refining Video Projects

II. Objective(s):

- This activity aims to add various enhancements to video projects, including text overlays, visual effects, images, transitions, narration, and audio effects.
- Also, it allows students to trim and crop video clips to improve focus and remove unnecessary parts.

III. Materials Needed:

- Computers or devices with a video editing application installed (e.g., iMovie, Adobe Premiere Pro, DaVinci Resolve, Final Cut Pro)
- Sample video clips and images for import (provided by the instructor or available online)
- Instructional handout or digital guide on adding enhancements and trimming/cropping in the chosen video editing application
- Microphones for recording narration (if not built into the device)
- Headphones for listening to audio effects

IV. Instructions:

1. Open the video editing application on your device.
2. Click on the "Import Media" button.
3. Select the provided sample video clips and images and import them into the media library.
4. Select a clip in the timeline.
5. Click on the "Titles" tab and choose a text style.
6. Drag and drop the text style onto the timeline above the video clip.
7. Edit the text in the preview window.
8. Select a clip in the timeline.
9. Click on the "Clip Filter and Audio Effects" button.
10. Choose and apply a visual effect from the available options.

11. Import an image file into the media library.
12. Drag and drop the image onto the timeline.
13. Adjust the duration and position of the image in the timeline.
14. Click on the "Transitions" tab.
15. Choose a transition effect.
16. Drag and drop the transition between two clips in the timeline.
17. Click on the "Voiceover" button.
18. Position the playhead where you want the narration to start.
19. Click "Record" and start speaking into the microphone.
20. Click "Stop" when done recording.
21. Import an audio file into the media library.
22. Drag and drop the audio file onto the timeline.
23. Click on the "Clip Filter and Audio Effects" button.
24. Choose and apply an audio effect.
25. Select a clip in the timeline.
26. Move the playhead to the point where you want to start trimming.
27. Use the trim tool to cut out unwanted sections from the beginning or end of the clip.
28. Select a clip in the timeline.
29. Click on the "Crop to Fill" button.
30. Adjust the cropping box in the preview window to focus on the desired area.
31. Apply the crop.
32. Sharing and Discussion (10 minutes):
33. Share your edited video with the class or in small groups.
34. Discuss the editing choices you made and any challenges you encountered.
35. Be guided with the rubric in developing this activity.
