I. Activity No. 1: Textile Swatch Book

II. Objective: To create a textile swatch book to familiarize oneself with various textiles and their characteristics.

III. Material:

- Fabric swatches representing different types of textiles (e.g., cotton, denim, silk, wool, polyester, etc.)
- Cardstock, sturdy paper, scrapbook
- Scissors
- Glue or adhesive tape
- Marker or pen

IV.a. Instructions:

Create a Textile Swatch Book by collecting at least 4 available fabric swatches in your home. Design or decorate your textile swatch book. Be creative!

What is a Swatch Book? Swatch book could be a collection of swatches that an artist or designer might put together for reference during a project. A swatch is a piece of cloth or fabric designed to represent a larger whole. A small sample, usually taken from existing fabric, is called a swatch.

Fabric swatches can be collected from your neighborhood fabric store or anything what is available in your home. In doing the activity make sure to include at least one fabric from each fiber category (natural fiber, synthetic fabric, natural cellulose, manufactured cellulose, etc.).

How to fill out the fabric details:

Fabric name: check the fabric name of your fabric swatch in the internet or in your local fabric store

Fiber content: *identify the type of fiber use in the fabric*

Care: check the care label of the fabric swatch, check whether the fabric can be prewashed or not, iron, bleach, etc. See care label instruction for this.
