Considering these concerns, this supplementary material is formulated to meet your needs. The activities will enhance your communication skills in both oral and written.







Brief Introduction

 - the acting out or performance of a particular role following a given/ prepared script
- show and tell
 - showing item/picture and describe what it is all about

- radio play/podcast/ broadcast/reporting
 - giving a spoken or written account of something that one has observed, heard, done, or investigated
- poster presentations
 - presenting understanding of a topic through drawing or sketch.
- graphic organizer
 - teaching and learning tool that is used to organize information and ideas in a way that is easy to comprehend.
- dialogue
 - > conversation between two or more people.


- Describe each state of matter.

Solids have a definite shape, meaning they do not need a container to give them shape. Solids retain their own shape. Solids also have a definite volume, meaning they take up the same amount of space no matter where or into what container they are placed.

Liquids do not have a definite shape. They take the shape of the container in which they are placed. However, like solids, liquids have a definite volume. This means they take up the same amount of space in any container in which they are placed.

Gases, like liquids, have no definite shape but take the shape of their container. Unlike liquids and solids, gases do not have a definite volume but spread out to fill the entire container in which they are placed.


