2. Identify the correct homonyms use in phrases and in sentences.





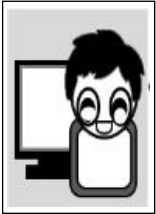

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This lesson provides you more opportunities to study more about homonyms. The knowledge you gained in previous grades will help you more in understanding the deeper meaning of homonyms and exploring the concept about it. Varied activities are provided for your better cognizance, and meaningful and enjoyable learning. So, let's begin.

- **Homonyms** are words that share the same spelling, regardless of pronunciation or words that share the same pronunciation regardless of spelling, or both.
- If homonyms share the same pronunciation or sound, regardless of spelling they are called **homophones**.
- If homonyms have the same spelling, regardless of pronunciation they are called "**homographs**."
- Therefore, it is possible for a homonym to be a homophone (same sound) and a homograph (same spelling).

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Example: Analyze the sentence properly.

1. flower- flour

My mother brought a beautiful **flower** yesterday.



My mother also bought some **flour** for her baking.



Explanation:

flower- flour is an example of homonyms that belongs to **homophones** (same sound regardless of the spelling)

2. bow-bow

The hunter breaks its **bow**.



The children **bow** to the audience happily after their dance.



Explanation:

bow- bow is an example of homonyms that belongs to **homographs** (same spelling, regardless of pronunciation)
